¹ Wednesday, March 9, DAY 1: DEPART THE U.S.A.

Depart this evening on an overnight flight from Dallas to Rome. Dinner and breakfast will be served on the plane.

Thursday, March 10, DAY 2: WELCOME TO ITALY - ROME - ORVIETO - ASSISI*

We meet our professional English-speaking tour director at the airport who assists us with luggage and bus boarding. We are on the way to Assisi! To break up our drive, we stop for lunch, in the beautiful hilltop town of Orvieto. We celebrate Mass, tour the Cathedral and see the Miracle of the Eucharist of Bolsena. Late afternoon arrival in the beautiful city of birds and silence of Assisi, where we have dinner and an overnight at our centrally located hotel. (L. D.)

¹ Friday, March 11, DAY 3: ASSISI

Considered one of the most peaceful spots in Italy, Assisi is a spiritual treasure. Today we explore Assisi, starting with a visit to St. Francis Basilica, where we celebrate Mass. Here we see the tomb of St. Francis and majestic works of art in the upper and the lower parts of the Basilica. We will walk the length of the town to the Church of St. Clare and to visit San Damiano and the Oratory of St. Francis. Free time for lunch on our own, and time at leisure to explore the city, before we board the bus for a short drive to the magnificent Basilica of Santa Maria Degli Angeli where we see the thornless rose bush. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B. D.)

Saturday, March 12, DAY 4: LORETO - LANCIANO - SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

Today we visit Loreto and see the Holy House of Nazareth, which tradition tells us, was transported here from the Holy Land. We have a chance to view the most reproduced Madonna in the world: the Black Madonna of Loreto. This afternoon we continue to Lanciano, to celebrate Mass at the Shrine of the Eucharistic Miracle of Lanciano. Here we see the Host of Flesh, from true flesh & blood resulting from the miracle that occurred in the 8th century during Mass, where the priest doubted the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Our day concludes with dinner and overnight in San Giovanni. (B. D.)

당unday, March 13, DAY 5: SAN GIOVANNI (St. Padre Pio) – ST. MICHAEL'S GROTTO

Our day is dedicated to St. Padre Pio. We begin with the celebration of Mass at the old Church of St. Maria delle Grazie. We honor St. Pio's work as we visit his tomb, the cell, the confessional and the Capuchin Monastery of Our Lady of Grace. We also see Padre Pio Pilgrimage Church, and the Home for the Relief of the Suffering. In the afternoon, we visit the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel. Dinner and overnight in San Giovanni. (B. D.)

がMonday, March 14, DAY 6: SANTA MARIA GORETTI – NETTUNO – ROME

This morning we drive to Nettuno, on our way we stop to see the American Cemetery and pay tribute to our brave soldiers who died in Italy during WWII. Upon arrival at the shrine, we see the Basilica of Our Lady of Graces and Saint Maria Goretti Shrine. We also see the reliquary that contains the saint's body in the Basilica and the farmhouse where she was murdered (the kitchen is now a chapel), as well as the room in which she lived. Mass will be celebrated at the Shrine. Following Mass, we head to Rome for dinner and overnight. (B. D.)

¹ Tuesday, March 15, DAY 7: ANCIENT ROME

This morning we tour the Forum and the Colosseum (inside visit). Our walking tour includes visits to the famous Trevi Fountain, the Spanish Steps, and the Pantheon. During our tour, we also visit Santa Maria della Minerva and the Church Sant' Agostino where St. Monica's relics are preserved. The church is aptly named after her son, Saint Augustine. Despite the rather plain exterior, the interior of the church is magnificent with several great works of art by artists such as Rafael and Caravaggio. Our walking tour ends at Piazza Navone, one of the most beautiful piazzas in Rome where you have several hours at leisure for lunch and for exploring the area. In the afternoon, we drive to St. Paul Outside the Walls, to celebrate Mass.

Wednesday, March 16, Day 8: CHRISTIAN ROME - PAPAL AUDIENCE

Early this morning, we are transferred to St. Peter's Square, where we are blessed by the Holy Father during the Papal Audience. Following lunch, we see the magnificent Cathedrals of Rome during the Christian Rome tour. Our first stop is the Basilica of St. Mary Major, where we celebrate Mass. We drive to the Basilica of St. John Lateran and the nearby Holy Stairs, before taking a short walk to the Basilica of Holy Cross in Jerusalem to see the sacred relics from the Holy Land. In the afternoon, we drive out of the city along the Appian Way to the Catacombs, where the early Christians prayed and buried their dead. Tonight, enjoy dinner at leisure. Overnight in Rome. (B)

Thursday, March 17, DAY 9: VATICAN TREASURES

This morning we are transferred to the Vatican, where we celebrate Mass and have a tour of St. Peter's Basilica. We meet our local guide who will take us to the Vatican Museum, to see the amazing works of art including the Raphael Rooms and the incomparable Sistine Chapel. After lunch on our own, the group is separated into smaller groups of no more than twelve people for a visit to the underground tunnels called the Scavi (TBC). Rest of the day is at leisure to explore Rome on your own. Tonight, we have a fun and festive farewell dinner as we remember all the beautiful moments we shared on this pilgrimage. Overnight in Rome.
